Ideas for Artwork (Advanced)

If the Teacher and Students have more time, we highly suggest Ideas for Artwork (Advanced). We highly recommend a topic from each category that represents what the school and/or city is doing to help support sustainability or climate change solutions. Suggestions for each **Green Megatrends Month** are recommended below **(you may use your own suggestions)**. Each poster illustration may be used as a lesson plan, link, or portal to more info about the initiative.

January, Sustainable Planning Month (You may use your own suggestions for each month) Create artwork that illustrates what the city or school is doing to promote energy efficiency (Including weatherization, insulation, heating and cooling, and lighting)

February, Sustainable Cities Month

Create artwork that illustrates the <u>US Mayors Climate Protection Agreement</u>.

March, Sustainable Agriculture and Forests Month

Create artwork that illustrates the school's flower or vegetable garden or city's Farmer's Market.

April, Climate Change Awareness Month

Create artwork that illustrates the school or city's green areas, tree planting, park district or forest preserves. If the school doesn't have a garden, you can choose one of these for March.

May, Renewable Energy Month/Clean Air Month

Create artwork that illustrates the school or city's clean air program, wind turbine or use of nontoxic cleaners. You can illustrate the kind of wind turbine you would like your school to have.

June, Solar Energy Month

Create artwork that illustrates a Solar Roof or Green Roof in the city or school. You can illustrate the type of solar roof or green roof you would like your school to have.

July, Energy Independence Month

Create artwork that **illustrates** public or green transportation used by students to get to school (including Bicycles, Hybrid or Electric Cars, Car Pooling, School Bus and Train).

August, Water Quality and Conservation Month

Create artwork that illustrates water conservation/quality used by city or school (eg, Rain Barrels).

September, Green Building Month

Create artwork that illustrates a LEED Building built (or being built) by the city or business in the city – such as a library or government building (including a Police or Fire Station. Or illustrate one you would like to be built (e.g., from a Google Image).

October, Sustainable Education Month

Create artwork that illustrates your school's best green initiative (or one you would for your school), your LEED certified school, or a LEED school you would like to see built (see Google).

November, Environmental Stewardship Month

Create artwork that illustrates the school or city's recycling program.

December, Green Giving Month

Create artwork that illustrates a Green Business or green activity of the Chamber of Commerce or Shopping Mall. You could even illustrate the outside or inside of a local Green Business.
